Dear Parents/Carers,

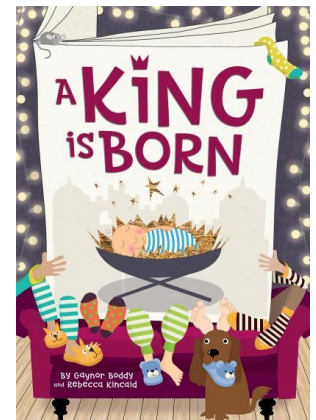
We are all getting really excited for all the Christmas festivities for the last two weeks of term – and that's just the adults! Here is an outline of all the important information that you need to know.

Swans Christmas play - Tuesday 6th (2pm) and Wednesday 7th December (5:30pm)

Our Swans children have been busy practising their lines and learning their songs, ready for this year's Christmas play! They are all very excited to perform **A King is Born**.

Performances take place in the school hall on Tuesday 6th (2pm) and Wednesday 7th December (5:30pm), and each will last approximately 30 minutes. **All children will need to attend both performances – please can children come to school for 5pm on the Wednesday so that they have plenty of time to get changed.**

Due to capacity restrictions, each family may have up to 3 seats per performance, and a separate letter should have been received with a reply slip.
