INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is “**Snarestone Church of England Primary School**”
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is “**The governing body of Snarestone Church of England Primary School**”
4. The governing body Snarestone Church of England Primary School makes the following statement relating to the character and ethos of the school:

**“Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the church at parish and diocesan level.**

**The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.”**

5. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a) **seven** foundation governors;
  - b) **two** parent governors;
  - c) **one** Local Authority governor;
  - d) **one** staff governor;
  - e) **one** headteacher.
6. Total number governors is **twelve**.
7. The term of office for all categories of governor is four years.
8. **One** foundation governor to be appointed by the Snarestone School and Exhibition Foundation
9. **Five** foundation governors to be appointed by the Leicester Diocesan Board of Education from nominations made by the Parochial Church Council of the Appleby Group of Churches.

10. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:

**The incumbent of the benefice of Appleby Magna and Swepstone with Snarestone and Norton-Juxta-Twycross.**

- (b) The Archdeacon of Loughborough shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named above in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his/her governorship exists. The said Archdeacon being the person nominated to propose the removal of the ex officio foundation governor.
11. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the headteacher if not a governor)
12. This instrument of government comes into effect on **26<sup>th</sup> August 2015**.
13. This instrument was made by order of the Leicestershire County Council on the *26* day of *August* 2015.
