World Book Day, Thursday 7th March

Our School Parliament have decided that we should do the following for World Book Day on 7th March:

- Dress up as your favourite book character and bring your favourite book into school to share. *If dressing up isn't your thing, then it's fine to just wear non-uniform, but we would still like all children to bring in their favourite book.*
- Decorate a hard-boiled egg (or eggs) with 'World Book Day' as the theme. Be creative - this could be a book character, or a whole egg scene! This is for fun, but there will also be a few prizes for the most 'cracking' egg designs! Entries can start coming into school from Monday 4th March and they must be displayed with your child's name. - During World Book Day week, children will be given a 'Book Bingo' challenge sheet, with book-related challenges to achieve during the week. Anyone who completes all the challenges will receive a bookmark at the end of the week!
